

Center Teachers Job Summary: An Open Arms Leadership Academy (OALA) Center teacher is responsible for supporting virtual school lessons, activities, and facilitating supplemental leadership lessons for students in grades K-2.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Support individual student virtual academic courses and provide tutoring when necessary.
- Model the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People and Leadership Principles and directly teach the concepts to students.
- Maintain a classroom climate that nurtures and supports a positive learning environment.
- Ensure students' safety during class activities.
- Monitor and assist with lunch and snack breaks.
- Attend scheduled staff meetings.
- Report to Center Administrators.

SCHEDULE: Teachers will be scheduled to work from Monday to Friday for the duration of virtual schooling. Teachers will be required to report for duty at 7:30 AM and will be released at 4:00 PM. They will be provided a one-hour lunch break each day.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must have two or more years of education experience working with either elementary or middle school children. They will be required to pass a criminal background check and get certified in CPR and First Aid. OALA will provide and cover the cost for this training.
