

Camp Teachers Job Summary: An Open Arms Leadership Academy Camp (OALA) substitute teacher is responsible for facilitating engaging classroom lessons and activities for students in grades K-8.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Model the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People and Leadership Principles and directly teach the concepts to students.
 - Maintain a classroom climate that nurtures and supports a positive learning environment.
 - Ensure campers' safety during class activities.
 - Utilize help from camp counselors.
 - Monitor and assist with lunch and snack breaks.
 - Attend scheduled staff meetings.
 - Report to Camp Manager.
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SCHEDULE: Teachers will be scheduled to work from Monday to Friday for nine weeks (May 26th to July 24th). They will have 2 shift options. 1st shift will arrive at 6:00 A.M. for early camp check in and end at 12:00 P.M. during lunch. The 2nd shift will arrive at 12:00 P.M. during lunch and end at 6:00 P.M. for late camp check out. Teachers also have the option to work both shifts if desired. They will be provided a one-hour lunch break each day.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must have two or more years of education experience working with either elementary or middle school children. They will be required to pass a criminal background check and get certified in CPR and First Aid. OALA will provide and cover the cost for this training.
